These top tips will help you to create successful resources:


- Make sure you have the right permissions for the content/images you use find out more about copyright in the author academy <u>here</u>
- Give your resource a title that is short, concise and contains vocabulary relevant to IB teachers – think about what you would type when searching for an IB-related resource
- Write a clear and accurate description of what the resource is so a teacher can easily work out whether it's what they're looking for


## Resources ready to go? Here's how to upload them:

Once you have a Tes account set up you can upload your resources by bookmarking this link to the *uploader tool*.


You'll be directed to a new page where you can upload (or drag and drop) your resource files, create a title and include a description telling others about your resource. You can add any video links associated to the resource and choose the images or screenshots you'd like as your cover image.



Next, select the appropriate age range(s) and subject(s) your resource targets. You can also select the IB programme your resource is tailored to, making it easier for other IB teachers to find.



Decide whether you want to share your resource for free or, if you'd like it to be a paid resource, decide how much you'd like to sell it for. Then click *continue*.



Finally, you'll need to check the box to confirm that the resource and its contents are your own to share/sell, and then click *publish now* to complete your upload.
